School Improvement Plan

The 2024-2025 School Improvement Plan has three goals based upon the overarching needs of our students and faculty: 1) Ensure academic achievement in reading and writing by meeting or exceeding the end of year school-wide goal of 85% of students achieving growth in Language Arts categories on the Iowa Basics yearly testing, 2) Enhance the rigor and relevance of curriculum and outcomes to ensure that all students have access and entry points to high-level content and skills, and 3) Ensure students have the skills and support necessary to grow in their Christian walk and service as they carry out the school theme: Anchored in Christ. Our teachers will also continue to work toward building the technological skills of our students. Mrs. Doss's kindergarten students are working on reading with more confidence as they approach the end of the year and being ready to read daily in first grade next year. They will be reading from their readers every day. They will also be reading one-vowel word cards, two-vowel word cards, special-sound clue cards, and sight words from the wall. Mrs. Doss's and HCS's goals for reading in kindergarten include wanting our students (your children) to love reading and learning to read well, so that they are able to read their Bibles as they grow in their walk with Christ, anchored in Him.
